## 2023 Scholarship Application

The Lafayette Chapter of Credit Unions is pleased to announce that we will offer three (3) \$1000 scholarships in 2023. Entries are accepted from members of several participating local credit unions. This scholarship is awarded through a random drawing among eligible applicants.

### Eligibility

To be considered for the chapter scholarship, you must:

- Be a member of one of the participating credit unions
- Be graduating from high school in the spring of 2023, or currently enrolled in undergraduate studies at an accredited college, university, or technical school or with plans to attend an accredited college, university or technical school full-time in the fall of 2023
- Have maintained a 3.0 GPA based on 6 high school semesters or 1 most recent, completed college semester
- Have scored a 21 or higher on the ACT exam
- Complete an application and personal essay

Immediate family members of current employees and Board of Directors of any of the participating credit unions **ARE NOT** eligible for the scholarship.

### Application Package

All applicants must submit an application package which includes:

- A completed application
- A current high school transcript or college transcript
- A copy of your official ACT or SAT results
- Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a teacher from your junior or senior year (only applies to high school seniors), or your current college professor or advisor
- A personal essay

### Application Deadline

Completed application packets must be received no later than Friday, March 31, 2023. Incomplete or late application packages will not be considered. Mail or hand-deliver applications to:

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### **Selection**

Only one application will be accepted from each participating member, regardless of membership at multiple participating credit unions. Each participating credit union will review the applications they receive and forward all qualified applications to the Scholarship Committee of the Lafayette Chapter of the Louisiana Credit Union League. Selection of the scholarship recipients will be made through a random drawing to be held at the April 2023 Lafayette Chapter of Credit Unions meeting.

### **Award**

The Scholarship Committee will award three (3) \$1,000 scholarships. The recipients can use the scholarship for any school related expenses. The recipients will receive the award payment in full in the form of a check. The check will be made payable directly to the recipients when proof of registration for the fall 2023 semester has been provided to the Scholarship Committee.

### **Notification**

Each applicant will be notified by mail whether or not they have been chosen as one of the scholarship recipients. The scholarship recipients will receive notification by April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
